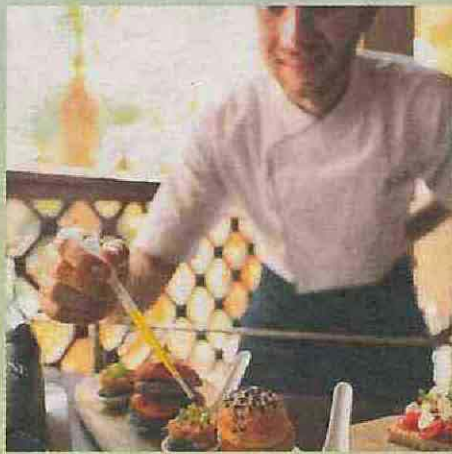


Brainwashed by Nature

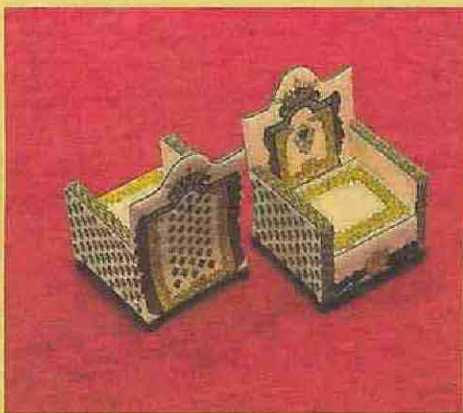
Plastic - group exhibition
