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BIOGRAPHY

Andrea Cagnetti, known by the artistic name Akelo, is an Italian goldsmith, designer, and sculptor internationally recognized for his highly intricate creative journey supported by studies and research in various fields. Born in 1967 in Corchiano (Viterbo), a town built on the ruins of the legendary Etruscan city of Fescennia, both the location and his upbringing led him to fulfill his destiny as an artist and master goldsmith.

From adolescence, he focused on ancient technologies related to metallurgy, ceramics, medicine, and the processing of glass and fabrics. After completing his scientific studies, he moved to Rome, where he worked as a graphic designer for several years. Eventually, he decided to leave the hectic pace of the big city to return to his hometown, dedicating himself exclusively to his vocation and adopting the artistic name Akelo (from Acheloo, the Greek god of waters). His artistic calling, far from being characterized by self-promotion, worldly pursuits, and tumultuous travels, is cultivated in a monastic retreat, in the silence and peace of the Etruscan land—much like a true Renaissance man who isolates himself in his tiny "workshop."

Today, Akelo's works draw inspiration from a body of studies ranging from ancient and alchemical knowledge to contemporary scientific inquiries, paying homage to both classicism and bold abstraction. Despite their considerable diversity, reflecting rare eclecticism and visionary qualities in the contemporary art scene, all his creations are permeated by a singular purpose: Beauty and Harmony. Exhibited in various national and international shows, some of his works have been acquired by significant museums and private collections. Akelo has received numerous accolades from critics, scholars, and





media worldwide, highlighting not only the artist's talent and stylistic originality but also the value of his research, studied in many art institutions.
